Honey and chrysanthemum flowers come together in an intriguing kosher and organic liqueur (\$23.99) from craft distiller Koval, the first distiller in Chicago since Prohibition. In making its liqueurs, Koval uses a white whiskey base which imparts a greater depth of flavor than with many other liqueurs. Austrian native Robert Birnecker, who grew up helping out at his family's distillery and winery, and his wife, Sonat, a former professor of Jewish studies, founded the company in 2008.
